ISA DANCE COMPETITION

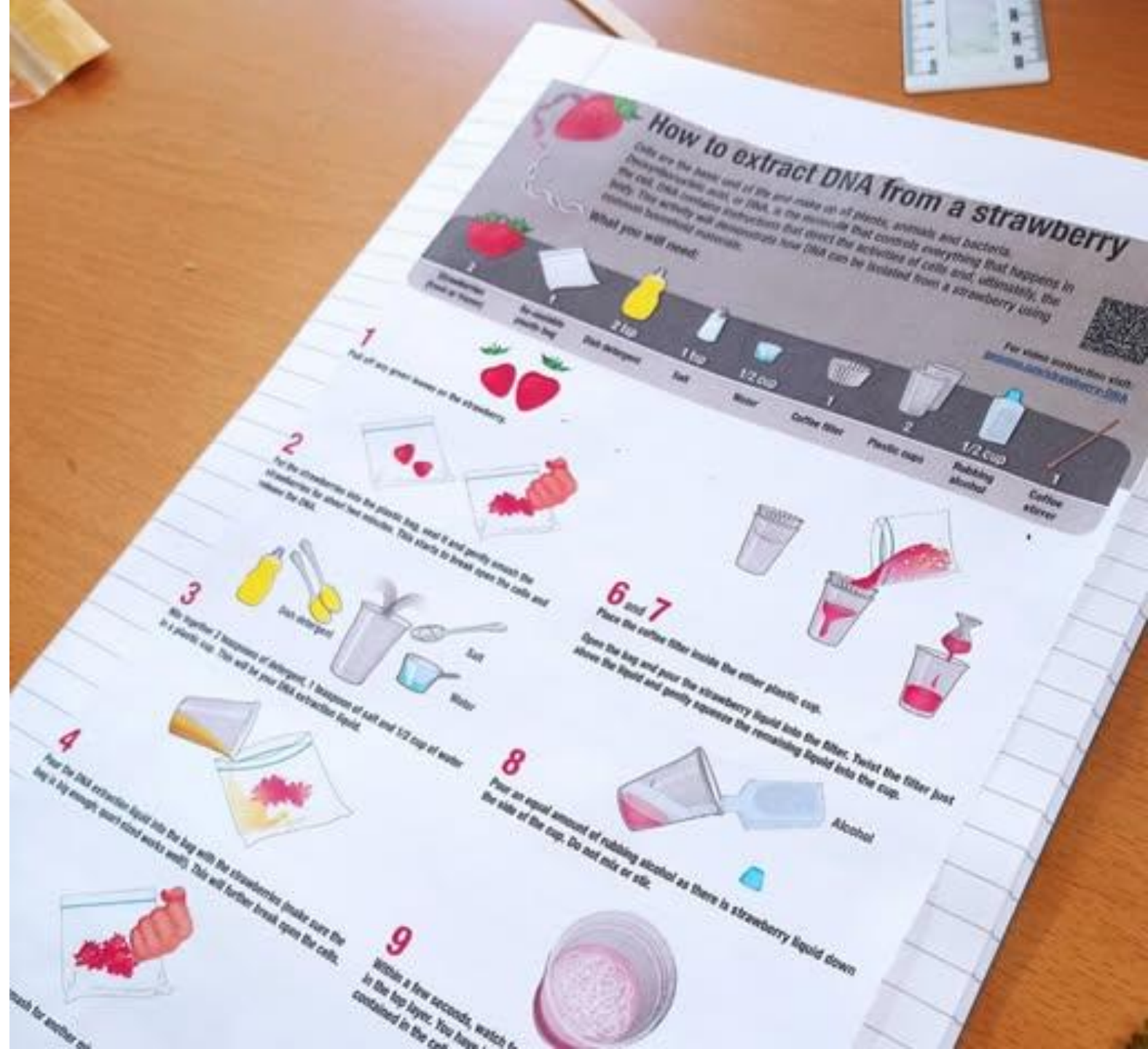
- 30 January 2025

DNA Experiment

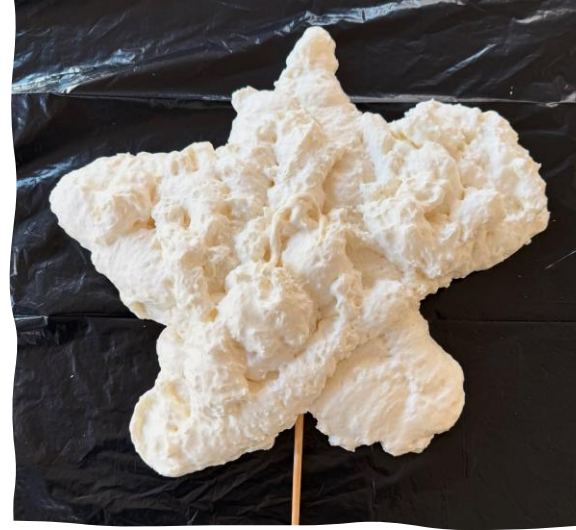
A very interesting lessons took place in Science with Year 9 and 10!

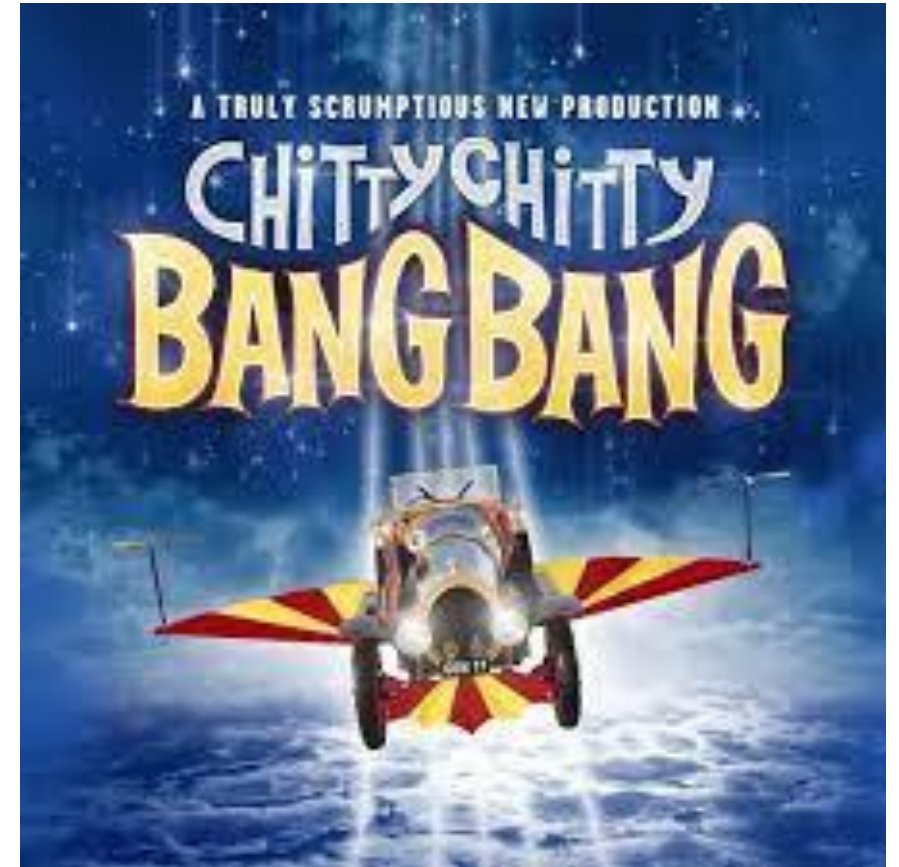
Michelle also took private singing lessons with students!!
